Dear Parents,

We are happy to meet you through the 2^{nd} letter of the current academic year of our school.

1. EDITORIAL

Artificial Intelligence has become the hottest sector since the company Open Al launched ChatGPT.

The rise of AI has led to a number of concerns and fears among people. One of the fears related to Artificial Intelligence is that it will replace human job.

Raw intelligence is a wonderful thing. We need the human touch, an emotional connect in most advisory roles. The second fear is that some countries will take always in Al giving them a huge advantage. It is indeed a true. The lead in Al is at a huge advantage. India must evolve our own Al models, so we have more representative Al. It needs hardware upgrade and must invest in advance chip design and machine.

This is technically possible, there are no theoretical limits to a system of intelligence that can keep self-improving to become even more intelligent. The human brain is very complex and involves several aspects other than intelligence.

We must realise the difference between intelligence and power. Power does not come automatically from intelligence. Human beings have to give power to someone.

Right now, it seems unlikely that we will handover machines the power to control us.


Anyway, Artificial intelligence will have a massive impact in the coming decades. All is here to stay, let's use our natural intelligence to harness it for the benefits of our nation.


