##### PTM-3 : 4<sup>TH</sup> JANUARY, 2025

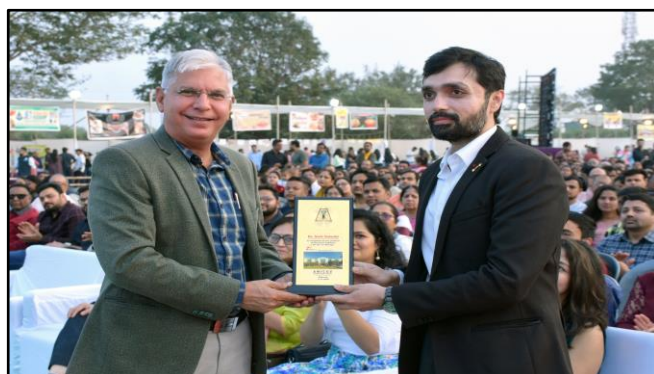
