Dear Parents,

We are happy to meet you through the **2nd** letter of the current academic year of our school.

1. EDITORIAL

Artificial Intelligence has become the hottest sector since the company Open AI launched **ChatGPT**.

The rise of AI has led to a number of concerns and fears among people. One of the fears related to Artificial Intelligence is that it will replace human job.

We must realise the difference between intelligence and power. Power does not come automatically from intelligence. Human beings have to give power to someone.

Right now, it seems unlikely that we will handover machines the power to control us.

Anyway, Artificial intelligence will have a massive impact in the coming decades. AI is here to stay, let's use our natural intelligence to harness it for the benefits of our nation.

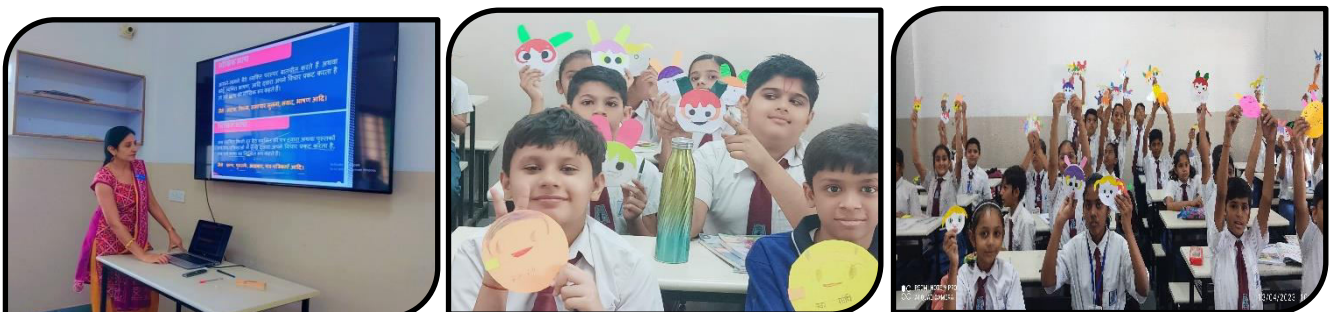

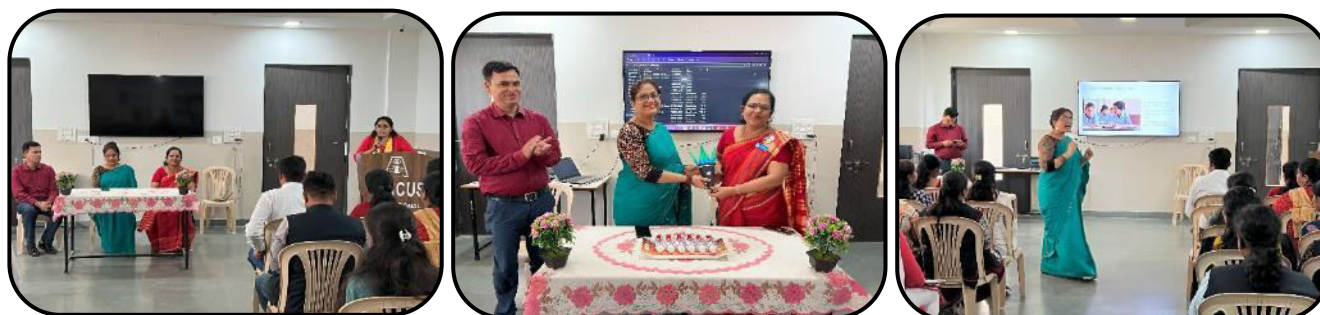
