PRINCIPAL WORKSHOP: 10TH JULY, 2025



Each destination sparked curiosity, learning, and a whole lot of excitement! A perfect blend of education and inspiration – our students truly had a blast!






FUN WITH ROBOTICS: JULY, 2025
