## 1. EDITORIAL

Dear Parents,

The **Gaza-Israel conflict** has a long and complex history dating back many decades. It centres on a dispute over land and the right to self-determination. Both Israelis and Palestinians claim the same region as their homeland, which has led to ongoing tensions and conflicts.

The key players in this conflict are the state of Israel and various Palestinian groups. Hamas, a Palestinian organization, controls the Gaza Strip, while the West Bank is governed by the Palestinian Authority. Israel, a country in the Middle East, has been a central part of the conflict.
